

GENERAL QUESTIONS

Can I access my room before the start of the school year?

Unfortunately we cannot allow students to move in prior to move-in day. Students who anticipate needing to move onto campus early, however, may petition to the Director of Housing. If space is available and the room is ready, the Director may allow an early check in to take place.

What should I bring with me (list of suggested items)?

Alarm clock, decorative shower curtain (if desired, we provided basic), silverware, trash can, toiletries, bedspread/comforter, sheets, throw pillows, mattress cover/pad, blankets, towels/linens, cleaning supplies/chemicals, flashlight, hangers, pictures, carpeting/rugs, ironing board, umbrella, refrigerator, microwave, TV, VCR/DVD Player, Radio/CD Player, Computer/Laptop, artwork/pictures, telephone, desk lamp, calling card, clothing, cable cord/splitter, first aid supplies, medicine, sewing kit

What should I keep at home and not bring with me?

Pets (only fish in tanks no larger than 10 gallons allowed), appliances with open coils/heating elements, halogen lamps, lofting kits/units, candles/flammable oils/incense materials, knives/firearms/weapons, fireworks, space heaters, hookahs/water pipes, gas grills, paint, lava lamps, power strips without built-in circuit breakers, large personal furniture that may not fit the space

Are the residence halls open for University breaks?

Currently, the residence halls do remain open during certain break periods. Staying over the break periods is not part of the annual contract period and therefore may be subject to an additional fee. Residents are responsible for keeping up with this information as it is released by the Department of Residential Life. If a student has a question regarding opening and closing of the residence halls, they should ask the Director of Housing so that they can coordinate their travel plans accordingly.

What should I do to ensure the security of my property?

You should lock all your valuables/personal possessions in a safe and secure location that only you can access. We recommend a safety box/safe with a combination lock that only you have the key/code to. We advise that if all parties are accounted for in your room that you deadbolt the front door lock for added security. Of course, when you are not in your apartment suite, it is always advisable that you lock the bedroom door and ensure that your front door closes securely behind you. Please don't allow yourself to become the victim behind a crime of opportunity.

May I store my boxes and other belongings somewhere on campus?
