- Completion of an associate's degree from Delta College as shown by official transcripts (additional Delta College courses may be required - see advisor).
- Completion of all coursework as shown above.
- A minimum of 120 credit hours are needed to obtain a B.B.A. from Northwood University.
- Residency Requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 30 earned credits at Northwood University, including at least 9 credits within their major discipline.
- All transfer coursework must be college-level; remedial coursework is not considered college-level.
- Students may incorporate additional minors or majors, but this will involve additional coursework; please see a Northwood University advisor.
